### **Principal's Report:**

-Enrolment is down by one but we are expecting 2 new students in November.

-Nancy attended the SAC conference at the Nova Centre in September. Dr Strang spoke about the benefits of the school lunch program. Providing healthy food options for students will have a positive impact on student achievement.

-\$2298 are the current Sac funds, \$400 for Domino Topple event was the last SAC expense. This event was very well received by the students.

### **Student achievement:**

**Literacy results:** Our priority is on our historically marginalized student groups; African Nova Scotians and Indigenous

**Immersion:** 14 of the 19 ANS students are meeting. 4 of the 8 Indigenous students are meeting. Of the two students who identify with both groups, both are meeting. 91 of the remaining 97 students in immersion are meeting.

**English:** 1 of the 6 ANS students is meeting. 3 of the 5 Indigenous students are meeting. Of the remaining 123 students, 97 are meeting.

On September 24<sup>th</sup> Nancy will be attending a professional development session on UDL. This approach focuses on the backwards design of an intended goal.

### **Provincial Lunch Program**

Lunch program begins October 28<sup>th</sup>. Parents can order lunch every day for their child. The lunches follow provincial nutrition guidelines and are pay-what-you-can or free. Lunches will be prepared off site by a vendor and delivered to the school in individual packaging.
